


Make sure any external speakers or headphones are plugged in to your computer and are turned on, with the volume up.



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

What will we learn in Math this year?

NUMBER SENSE

We will focus on counting and writing numbers. Students will learn to organize and separate objects and build numbers into sets of ten.

THINKING & OPERATIONS

We will begin to make sense of quantities and patterns and use written numbers to represent concepts. By the end of the year, students be able to add and subtract up to 10.

<u>GEOMETRY</u>

We will learn to identify different shapes, work with shapes, and describe the positions of objects.

<u>MEASUREMENT & DATA</u>

We will learn concepts of length and weight. Students will learn to classify and represent data in different ways. Click Here for

What will we learn in ELA this year?

INQUIRY & INVESTIGATION

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Students work together to develop questions and gather information. They begin to generate possible explanations and develop alternatives. These abilities serve as the basis for critical thinking and problem-solving skills.

LEARNING TO READ

Students focus on the written word. They work to recognize the relationship between letters, sounds, and words, and how they give meaning.

<u>WRITING</u>

Students work to share their ideas on paper using drawings, words, and dictation to describe an event or tell a story. As the year goes by, students begin to use basic punctuation and English grammar.

READING FOR ENJOYMENT

Students learn to identify and understand the parts of a book and a story, and how those parts influence the meaning.

COMMUNICATION

Students work on listening to others, explaining their ideas, and responding to the ideas of others. They begin to study different ways to improve their communication skills.

READING FOR INFORMATION

Students ask the basic questions: who, what, when, where, why, and how. Now they begin to learn how to Gain and apply information and ask further questions.



DRAs are given throughout the academic year. It is required that students complete the assessment. It helps us get a better understanding of what your child needs to learn and lets us know what your child's reading level is.


Let's check out a Level 3 book.

This is considered on-grade level by the end of the year.




We will have live classes Mondays - Thursdays unless we let you know something different.




